DEADLY CATCH bumped with a rival at the start, was rated off the pace, dropped back leaving the backstretch, raced three wide early on the turn, dropped to the inside approaching the five-sixteenths pole, rallied inside in upper stretch, closed well to get the lead near the furlong marker then edged clear under strong urging. CUPID'S HIT contested the pace on the inside of GEORGIA GLITTER while off the inside, inched clear while three wide on the turn, was set down in upper stretch, lost the lead near the furlong marker and was outfinished while able to hold the place. NATAWAKI settled off the pace, raced three wide on the turn, came four wide into the stretch, was put to a drive near the three-sixteenths pole and finished willingly to get the show. TEY'S BIG BOY was bumped in the early going, settled off the pace, raced four wide on the turn, came five wide into the stretch, was asked for more while between rivals near the three-sixteenths pole and lacked the needed kick then just missed the show. BUTTER BROWN was last away, moved up to be well placed just off the pace, was urged along while off the rail on the turn, came under stronger urging in upper stretch and lacked the needed response. GEORGIA GLITTER bumped with a rival at the start, came out early and bumped with ALCAZAR, contested the pace on the outside, chased four wide on the turn and tired. ALCAZAR was bumped early and forced into another rival, raced just off the pace while under restraint, went five wide on the turn, came six wide into the stretch and also lacked the needed response.
