Footnotes

BLUE TWISTER bumped with rivals at the start, pressed the pace, vied off the rail on the turn, jostled with ALCAZAR near the eighth-pole, battled gamely in the final furlong and narrowly prevailed under strong right hand urging. TRIBUTE TO WOLF bumped with a rival after the start, settled towards the inside, raced inside while behind traffic early on the turn, came off the rail near the five-sixteenths pole, lacked room and bumped repeatedly with PROPER CAT at

the top of the stretch, regained momentum and moved out near the furlong marker, rallied on the outside and closed well to just miss in an unlucky journey. ALCAZAR bumped with a rival at the start, was never far back, made a bid while three wide on the turn, jostled with BLUE TWISTER near the furlong marker and was outfinished while able to get the show. TOO MANY DETAILS chased the early pace then raced just behind the leader, went two to three wide on the turn, held a good striking position into the final furlong but lacked the needed kick and missed the show. HUNTER MAN CAN lacked early speed and raced well back in the field, went three then four wide on the turn, moved out while on the wrong lead in upper stretch and finished well while still on the wrong lead to just miss the minor awards. REDHOTRUSH was bumped on both sides after the start, dropped back while in tight along the rail early, moved to the outside and was ridden along near the back, went five wide on the turn, came seven wide into the stretch and finished willingly but also missed the minor awards. JUSMOVE bumped with a rival after the start, raced well back in the field while near the inside, shifted three wide in the vicinity of the five-sixteenths pole, was guided out in upper stretch and also finished willingly. DANNY ERL was last away, moved up to race just off the pace, went three to four wide on the turn, loomed a threat into the final furlong but weakened. DANCINFROMTHEGITGO bumped with a rival at the start and was pinched back, raced well back in the field, moved out in the stretch and gained ground but failed to menace. BANTA brushed with a rival at the start, raced just off the pace, was hard ridden while off the rail on the turn and came up empty. STUCK IN LEESTOWN settled on the outside, was taken back to avoid being wide inside the half-mile pole, raced three then two wide on the turn, swerved out in upper stretch and was no factor. SECRET BUCKLE was urged along at the back of the leading group, went four to five wide on the turn, moved to six wide entering the stretch and came up empty. PROPER CAT broke outward at the start, showed good speed and set the pace, dropped out while in a bit tight near the five-sixteenths pole, bumped repeatedly with TRIBUTE TO WOLF at the top of the stretch and faded.
