SUNWAVE outrun early, advanced outside entering the second turn, responded with authority entering the drive and wore down front running SOUTH CHINA SEA the final furlong. SOUTH CHINA SEA dueled from the inside for the early lead, gained a clear margin up the backstretch, held a clear margin through the second turn, held a clear advantage at the eighth pole but could not last. BARBEQUE SWINGER chased the early pace from the outside, inched closer entering the second turn, responded when asked but could not sustain the effort. CHRISAGOGO unhurried from the inside, advanced entering the second turn, responded but was too late. MONSIEUR HOOD forced the early pace from the inside but had nothing left for the drive. ROYALTY RED CAT was no factor. GOOFY GOVERNOR was no threat. ANNI'S STORM dueled from the outside early then tired in the drive.
