CANDIANO well placed from the outside, advanced entering the second turn, responded to pressure to gain a clear advantage deep stretch then held sway. EIGHTH AT CITYPARK outrun early, advanced inside entering the second turn, altered outside, responded and was getting to the winner. HEAVENVILLE stalked the early pace from the outside, made a bid entering the second turn, gained a short advantage at the eighth pole but could not last. MR. PORTER pressed the early pace from between foes, remained forward for the drive but could not keep pace. DYNAPAC was no factor. BLUEHARD dueled from the outside and tired. DYNAMIC TIME dueled from the inside and tired.
