Footnotes

BLUEHARD showed good speed, set the pace on the inside, was asked after turning into the stretch, shook clear under a drive and held well under strong urging. TACKY ANGEL settled while under some urging, inched closer while a bit off the rail on the turn, raced behind horses into the stretch, shifted out approaching the three-sixteenths pole and finished willingly for the place. STORM OSIDY chased the pace, raced off the rail on the turn and lacked the needed kick while able to get the show. HENRY'S TEDDYBEAR settled off the pace, was urged along while two to three wide on the turn, moved in approaching the furlong marker and lacked the needed response. KNOT FLOYD was coaxed along while off the pace, raced three wide on the turn, shifted four wide into the stretch and came up empty. ROYAL TAK settled at the rear, went four wide on the turn, came five wide into the stretch and failed to threaten. FREEDOM RUN tracked the pace on the outside, chased three wide on the turn and tired.
