MY BELL BOY raced three to four wide on the first turn, settled on the inside of LAFOURCHE, moved closer while three to four wide on the far turn, gained the lead at the top of the stretch, drifted in while moving clear outside the three-sixteenths pole, opened a sizeable advantage into the final furlong and proved much the best under urging then was eased up in the final strides. MIGHTY ELK raced two then three wide on the first turn, contested the pace on the outside, vied three then two wide on the far turn, lost the lead to MY BELL BOY at the top of the stretch, altered course to the outside when that rival drifted in and safely secured the place. REW'S BLUES broke through the gate prior to the start, was unhurried at the back while towards the inside, moved closer with a half-mile to run, was roused near the five-sixteenths pole, moved out once straightened for the drive and failed to rally while best of the rest. COUPLE OF HOURS threw his head and resisted the rating tactics of the rider early, moved up while eager on the first turn, jumped a shadow outside the three-quarter pole, contested the pace on the inside, dropped out midway through the far turn and gave way. TOO MANY DETAILS was caught five wide early on the initial turn then dropped to one off the rail, settled near the back of the field, was urged along while two then three wide on the far turn and failed to respond. LAFOURCHE raced four to five wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, was urged along while three to four wide on the far turn and came up empty then returned in distress after the race and was vanned off.
