JUMPIN FOR JASON was urged along while off the pace, raced two then three wide early on the turn, moved to four wide near the five-sixteenths pole, rallied while still four wide into the stretch, gained the lead near the three-sixteenths pole, inched clear into the final furlong and held off the determined COUPLE OF HOURS under strong urging. COUPLE OF HOURS chased the pace on the outside, raced four then three wide on the turn, was put to a right-handed whip in upper stretch, chased determinedly in the final furlong but missed while clear for the place. SILENT COUNT settled towards the rear, was urged along while three wide on the turn and finished willingly for the show. HANNAS AGENDA was urged along while just off the pace, raced three then two wide on the turn, came under stronger urging near the five-sixteenths pole and lacked the needed response. EAGLE FALLS brushed with a rival at the start, dueled on the outside, inched clear at the top of the stretch, lost the lead near the three-sixteenths pole and gave way. COLLEGE FUND settled towards the inside, was urged along while saving ground on the turn and failed to rally. REDHOTRUSH dueled on the inside EAGLE FALLS, vied inside on the turn and tired. LEEISIANA BLUES brushed with a rival at the start, raced at the rear of the field, went three then four wide on the turn and failed to threaten.
