DADDY'S SONG pressed the pace on the outside, took the lead at the quarter-pole, edged clear in upper stretch and drew away under strong urging. SPLURGESS set the pace under pressure, vied inside on the turn, lost the lead at the quarter-pole and proved no match for the winner while able to get the place. LUCKY FUNGO settled towards the rear, was urged along while off the rail on the turn, shifted out near the furlong marker and got up for the show. TRULY MAJESTIC broke out at the start, was ridden along on the outside, chased three wide on the turn and tired. DAY GLOW settled off the pace, was urged along while inside on the turn and failed to threaten. NOTHING TO NOTHING settled early then moved out midway down the backstretch, was urged along while three then four wide on the turn and failed to respond. MAID FOR WAR settled in the middle of the field, was urged along while off the rail on the turn and came up empty.
