Footnotes

BLUE VIOLET settled on the inside, moved closer while coaxed along on the far turn, came off the rail at the quarter-pole, espied a seam when BOOK CLUB drifted out in upper stretch, came through to take the lead, edged clear into the final furlong, extended the advantage under the whip into the final sixteenth then was hand ridden late while much the best. DREAMGLIDER saved ground on the first turn, lagged at the rear, moved closer while inside on the far turn, came off the rail around the furlong marker and safely secured the place. BOOK CLUB went two to three wide on the first turn, tracked the pace on the inside of a rival, vied off the rail on the far turn, drifted out some in upper stretch and tired while just able to get the show. ABUNDANTLY CLEAR went four to five wide early on the first turn, dropped to three wide late on that bend, was reserved off the pace, raced in the two path early on the far turn, shifted four wide while under urging at the three-eighths pole, chased into upper stretch and came up empty. LOVE BLIND (ARG) came off the rail on the first turn, set the pace through quick fractions, vied inside on the far turn and weakened. ON THE SAME PAGE went three to four wide on the first turn, tracked the pace on the outside, chased three wide on the far turn and stopped. DADDY'S SONG broke out at the start, went five to six wide on the first turn, settled near the back, raced four wide into the far turn, dropped to one off the rail near the three-eighths pole and faltered.
