Footnotes

EDEN PRAIRIE set the pace while off the rail, came three wide into the stretch, moved in and out while under a drive in upper stretch and held sway under steady urging. FLASHY GAL was reluctant to load, went three then two wide on the first turn, settled off the pace, moved closer while off the rail on the far turn, was asked at the quarter-pole, chased in the stretch and finished willingly for the place. SO DO PRAYERS lost her footing at the start and broke about two lengths behind, went three then two wide on the first turn, lagged at the rear, moved closer while two then three wide on the far turn, swung six wide into the stretch and finished with late energy to garner the show. DANCE AGAIN was reserved off the pace, saved ground while under urging on the far turn, chased in upper stretch, was in tight near the furlong marker and weakened. KIPLING'S JOY was carried six wide early on the first turn then dropped to three wide, raced off the pace while under some restraint, was asked while two then three wide on the far turn, swung five wide into the stretch and lacked the needed response. FRANKY AND JANE was rank into the first turn, bore out to be six wide early on that bend then dropped to three wide, tracked the pace on the outside while still eager, chased three wide on the far turn, shifted four wide into the stretch and tired. DADDY'S SONG was carried seven wide early on the first turn then dropped to four wide, settled on the outside, went five to six wide on the far turn, floated eight wide into the stretch and faltered. (Rail at 15 Feet)
