BLUE CLIFF was well placed just off the pace, moved up near the half-mile pole, drafted behind the leader while near the inside on the turn, waited from the quarter-pole to near the three-sixteenths pole, found a large opening at that point, rallied under hand urging to take the lead before the sixteenth-pole then drew clear without the use of the whip. LUCKY FUNGO settled towards the back, went two then three wide early on the turn, moved to four wide while advancing late on the bend, rallied to the lead in upper stretch, led into the final furlong, was headed by the winner before the sixteenth-pole and proved no match while able to get the place. DADDY'S SONG was reluctant to load, tracked the pace on the outside, ranged up while three then two wide on the turn, drew even at the quarter-pole, battled into the final furlong and tired while just able to hold the show. GIMME YO NUMBER raced just behind the leader while just inside DADDY'S SONG, went two then three wide on the turn, chased in upper stretch, angled out near the furlong marker and weakened then missed the show. FAVOR was urged along while near the back, went three then four wide early on the turn, advanced while five wide late on the bend then came up empty. SLAMMIN ANNIE was ridden along at the rear, raced off the rail on the turn and failed to threaten. ARE WE THERE YET set the pace, raced off the rail early on the turn then dropped close to the inside, lost the lead inside the quarter-pole and gave way.
