FAVOR broke out at the start, settled off the pace, went three then four wide on the turn, was asked near the five-sixteenths pole, rallied to the lead outside the furlong marker and edged clear under strong urging. DADDY'S SONG was fractious behind the gate, set the pace under pressure, vied off the rail on the turn, came under the whip in upper stretch, lost the lead outside the furlong marker and proved no match while just able to get the place. REPENTACIOUS bumped with a rival at the start, chased the pace, made a bid while three wide on the turn, battled under a drive in upper stretch and also proved no match for the winner then just missed the place. LIBBIES MISSION chased the pace, went two then three wide on the turn, lugged out a bit late on the bend and tired. DAY GLOW broke out at the start, was forwardly placed on the outside, ranged while four wide on the far turn, chased in upper stretch and came up empty. LUCKY FUNGO was last away then taken up, settled at the back, raced inside early on the turn then floated three wide and was no factor. ARE WE THERE YET pressed the pace on the inside, chased along the rail on the turn and capitulated. MAID FOR WAR bumped with an opponent at the start, steadied while in tight early, was coaxed along on the outside, went four wide on the turn and failed to respond.
