Footnotes

POPOVER between horses early, stalked outside a rival then off the rail, bid alongside the pacesetter on the second turn, took the lead into the stretch, kicked clear, drifted in and drew off under a left handed crack of the whip and steady handling. DANETTE saved ground stalking the pace, came out on the second turn and three deep into the stretch, drifted in and held second. META MU hopped at the start but broke on top, chased outside then off the rail, went three deep into the second turn and four wide into the stretch and bested the others. COOL MOVES sped to the early lead, set the pace inside, duelled along the rail leaving the second turn and weakened in the stretch. I HEART YOU chased inside then a bit off the rail, continued alongside a rival on the second turn and weakened. LILIES AND ROSES angled in and chased outside a rival, went three deep leaving the backstretch and on the second turn and had little left for the stretch. AWESOME DIAMOND (IRE) pulled early and chased outside a rival then between foes into and on the second turn and also had little left for the drive. ONE GUN stalked inside then a bit off the rail, dropped back between foes on the second turn, gave way and was eased in the final furlong. LARKING broke slowly, drifted wide into the first turn, settled off the rail, went up four wide leaving the backstretch and on the second turn, dropped back on that turn, angled in some, also gave way and was eased in the stretch.
