Footnotes

EMPELLISH THE LACE came inward leaving the starting gate, was taken hold, avoiding contact with the nearest opponent, established control well before reaching the end of the homestretch, rated kindly on a loosely-contested lead, entrenched in the two path, cut over to the rail coming to the half mile pole, continued along showing the way for the next quarter, felt some pressure during the last few strides prior to the quarter pole, and got set down in response to it, emerged from the furlong grounds holding her biggest advantage, dug in with good determination to cross the wire in front, kept to the task at hand. I'M A CHATTERBOX lunged out at the start, bobbled right afterwards, took up position in the middle of the field pulling on the bit getting placed towards the two path, loosely drafted behind foes, at first behind the winner and then behind CURALINA, continued to patiently keep watch on the winner until midpoint on the far turn, was let out a notch coming to the five-sixteenths marker, spun into the stretch under much stronger handling while being taken outward, completed the maneuver having been fanned about five to six wide, began the final furlong as the primary pursuer, closed in steadily despite lugging in from the eighth pole to the sixteenth marker, ultimately failed to catch the winner while well clear of the others for place honors. CURALINA stalked the top one three wide on the first turn, remained along that route all the way down the backstretch, migrated together with the winner closer to the rail at the top of the second bend, stayed within range, although only applying a smattering of pressure on the pacesetter, got called upon for the drive and got outfinished. DANETTE made no impact off a ground-saving trip. INCLUDE BETTY outrun early, swung four wide into the backstretch, was one path closer to the inside exiting it, got angled out into the five path heading for the three-sixteenths pole, had no offering. LOVELY MARIA hung out four wide on the clubhouse turn, was one lane closer to the rail on the subsequent one, entered the stretch having been put to a drive, made no headway. SWEETGRASS took up the chase from the two path and gave way.
