Footnotes

KITE was well placed while off the rail, came under urging at the five-sixteenths pole, rallied four wide into the stretch, took the lead outside the furlong marker, inched clear into the final sixteenth and held under strong urging. CASTLEDERG raced in the two path on the first turn, lingered well back in the field, saved ground early on the far turn, shifted four wide late on that bend, came five wide into the stretch, rallied on the outside and closed strongly to just miss. ALSHUJAA went five wide early on the first turn then dropped to the three path, settled on the outside, was urged along while three to four wide on the far turn, came five wide into the stretch and finished willingly for the show. DUALY AFFIRMED bumped hard with a rival at the start, went five wide early on the first turn then dropped to the three path, tracked the pace on the outside, came under some urging on the far turn, shifted three wide into the stretch, took the lead near the three-sixteenths, lost the advantage before the furlong marker and weakened. STOCKHOLDER bumped with a rival at the start, saved ground on the first turn, settled towards the rear, went two to three wide on the far turn and improved position. TIZ PEGASUS bumped hard with an opponent at the start then was taken up, went three wide on the first turn, lagged at the rear, raced in the two path on the far turn and also improved position. MAJESTIC STRATEGY went three wide early on the first turn then dropped to the inside, set the pace through moderate fractions, vied inside on the far turn, came off the rail at the top of the stretch, lost the lead before the three-sixteenths and gave way. CANDY GRAN bumped with rivals at the start, lugged out into the first turn, went four wide early on that bend then dropped to the two path, was urged along on the backstretch, went three wide on the final turn and failed to respond. CASE'S TICKET settled well off the pace, was urged along while off the rail on the far turn and failed to threaten. MAJOR TOOLIGHT bumped with a rival at the start, saved ground on both turns and came up empty. (Rail at 7 Feet)
