**Footnotes**

BLUE HARBOR a bit slow to begin, angled in and settled inside, came out on the second turn and six wide into the stretch, came in on the lead despite left handed pressure in midstretch then won clear under urging. BIG DISCOVERY angled 1/4, in and saved ground chasing the pace, split horses into the second turn, came four wide into the stretch, bid between rivals and steadied when crowded in midstretch, angled in and gained the place. MILTEE

unhurried and angled in a bit off the rail early, came out leaving the second turn and four wide into the stretch and bested the rest. DUALY AFFIRMED stalked a bit off the rail, bid between horses into the second turn, put a head in front, fought back just off the rail in midstretch, was forced in some at the eighth pole and weakened. PASSINAFASH four wide into the first turn, stalked between foes then three deep on the second turn, came five wide into the stretch, steadied when crowded between rivals in midstretch and lacked the needed late kick. HAZARDOUS DREAMS stalked outside a rival then between foes leaving the backstretch, bid three deep on the second turn, put a head in front into the stretch, steadied between horses in midstretch and weakened. GIN RIKI five wide into the first turn, stalked four wide, fell back some leaving the second turn and three deep into the stretch and weakened. VILLAGE KITTEN pulled between horses and was in tight into the first turn, chased between foes, dropped back a bit off the rail on the second turn and also weakened. BROKE THE MOLD was in a good position stalking the pace along the inside to the stretch and also weakened. IMAGINATIVE sped to the early lead, set the pace along the inside, fought back on the second turn but weakened in the stretch. SCREAMING TAP broke a bit slowly, settled off the rail then drifted out into the first turn, went outside a rival on the backstretch, fell back into the second turn and gave way. RODEADO chased outside a rival then off the rail, came out into the stretch and had little left for the drive. The stewards conducted an inquiry into the stretch run but made no change when they ruled the trouble to the runner-up did not alter the original order of finish.
