**Footnotes**

FANCY SHOES stalked outside then between horses on the backstretch, moved up three deep leaving the second turn, took the lead outside the runner-up in upper stretch, inched away in midstretch, drifted out from the whip some but won clear under urging. BLAME IT ON TEKELA stalked inside then bid along the rail on the backstretch to duel for the lead, took the advantage and inched away on the second turn, came a bit off the fence into the stretch, fought back in upper stretch and was clearly second best. BURNING angled in and settled off the pace inside, came out on the second turn and four wide into the stretch and edged a foe late for the show. FLEXIBLE stalked the pace outside then three deep to the stretch and was edged late for third. WILD broke a bit slowly, angled in and settled outside a rival to the stretch and lacked a rally. LUCKY SHOES TO WIN stalked outside a rival then bid three deep on the backstretch and into the second turn, continued off the rail into the stretch and weakened. SALT OF THE EARTH broke a bit slowly and was squeezed, settled just off the fence to the stretch and lacked a rally. MIGHTY PLEASING saved ground chasing the pace to the stretch and lacked a further response. DUALY AFFIRMED angled in and pulled hard under a hold and steadied into the first turn, saved ground chasing the pace to the stretch and weakened. GEMMABETO sent to the early lead, set the pace a bit off the rail then duelled between horses on the backstretch and into the second turn, angled in

leaving that turn and had little left for the stretch.
