Footnotes

ALL THAT SCAT was a bit reluctant to load, went three to four wide on the first turn, raced just off the pace while under restraint, was kept in by RIDE THE TIMES late on the backstretch, went three wide on the far turn, turned into the stretch behind a trio of rivals, was blocked from the three-sixteenths pole to the eighth-pole, shifted out for room, rallied quickly on the outside, closed fast to get the lead inside the sixteenth-pole then moved clear under steady handling. ROYAL GUARDIAN broke out and bumped with a rival, raced off the rail on the first turn, lagged near the back, was urged along while three wide on the far turn, came four wide into the stretch, advanced on the outside under a drive, was pulled out some nearing the sixteenth-pole to give relief to KITE and finished with good energy to secure the place. KITE went three to four wide on the first turn, was reserved on the outside, jostled with a rival entering the far turn, raced in the two path on that bend, angled out under a left-handed whip in upper stretch, steadied when ALL THAT SCAT came out outside the sixteenth-pole, regained momentum late and finished well to get the show at the wire. DUALLY AFFIRMED bumped soundly with RIDE THE TIMES at the start, went two to three wide on the first turn, prompted the pace on the outside, vied two to three wide on the far turn, came under a drive in upper stretch, battled into the final sixteenth and was outfinished then just missed the show. RIDE THE TIMES bumped soundly with DUALLY AFFIRMED at the start, went two to three wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, chased four wide on the far turn, made a bid in upper stretch, battled into the final sixteenth and was also outfinished then missed the superfecta. MAGICAL EIGHT was away a bit awkwardly, raced off the rail early on the first turn then dropped to the inside, set the pace, vied off the rail early on the far turn then dropped to the inside, came under the whip in upper stretch and weakened. CAUSE I'M GOLD bumped with a rival at the start, dropped to the inside on the first turn, was reserved off the pace, jostled with KITE leaving the backstretch then checked sharply while shuffled, saved ground into the stretch and failed to rally. CONNOR'S ACE was bumped on both sides at the start, saved ground on the first turn, lingered at the back, raced towards the inside on the far turn, moved out in upper stretch and was no factor. Following the race, the rider of KITE claimed foul against ALL THAT SCAT for alleged interference outside the sixteenth-pole. After the stewards' review, there was no change made to the order of finish. (Rail at 0 Feet)
