Footnotes

ACES HIGH was rated on the inside, moved up with five furlongs to run then took the lead, inched clear while along the rail on the far turn, drew off when asked in upper stretch, was put to stronger encouragement at the furlong marker and widened under steady urging. SCAT LEADER raced inside early on the first turn, shifted three wide late on that bend, was forwardly placed on the outside, chased while three to four wide on the far turn, was hard ridden into the stretch and proved no match while able to get the place. DIXIE WINTER broke out then was corrected by the rider, raced off the rail while under restraint on the first turn, moved up with five furlongs to run, was coaxed along in the two path on the far turn, came under a stronger ride at the five-sixteenths, chased into the stretch and came up empty. SIGNAL HILL went two to three wide on the first turn, set the pace, lost the lead midway down the backstretch, was urged along while two to three wide on the far turn and faded. DUALLY AFFIRMED was taken back early, raced rank while four to five wide through the first turn then was reserved off the pace, was urged along in the two path on the far turn and failed to respond. ACT OF HEROISM went three to four wide on both turns and faltered. BROUSSARD went two to three wide on the first turn, settled off the pace, dropped back while urged along at the half-mile pole and retreated.
