STRONG AND TOUGH far back early, advanced outside up the backstretch, made a bid entering the turn, responded when asked entering the drive and found his best stride in time. FIFTY ACRES stalked the early pace from the outside, steadily advanced through the turn, responded to gain a short margin deep stretch but was caught the final stride. DUBLIN DA'BET pressed the early pace from the inside, crept closer entering the turn, responded but could only gain the show. LEMON SHERBERT chased the early pace from the outside, made a bid and had good energy late. JAKE JOURDAN dueled from the outside early, gained a clear margin through the turn, remained clear at the eighth pole but shortened stride late. DONE GONE dueled from the inside early and tired. SOCIAL MISFIT was no factor. FOREIGN PRODUCTION had a steady fade. LEESTOWN'S OMEGA trailed throughout.
