Footnotes

DUBLIN DA'BET tracked the pace on the outside, was asked midway through the turn, made a bid at the five-sixteenths, was put to a left-handed whip in upper stretch, battled with the runner-up into the final furlong then edged clear under strong urging. VIKING WARRIOR broke a step slow, raced just off the pace while on the outside, ranged up while three wide on the turn, made a bid at the quarter-pole, came under a right-handed whip in upper stretch, switched to a left-handed whip outside the sixteenth-pole and was outfinished while clear for the place. TOTAL IMMERSION had a shoe repaired in the paddock, was urged along at the rear, went two to three wide on the turn, brushed with K T'S GOLDEN YEAR at the five-sixteenths, shifted four wide into the stretch, had the rider lose his whip late and lacked the needed kick. COMBATLAAN set the pace through reasonable fractions, vied inside on the turn, was asked at the quarter-pole, lost the lead to the winner, dropped back under a drive and weakened. ZARBY'S DERBY DAY was rated just off the pace, raced in the two path while coaxed along on the turn, shifted three wide into the stretch, moved out under a drive and lacked the needed response. K T'S GOLDEN YEAR was rated while lugging out some, dropped back while lugging out badly on the turn, brushed with TOTAL IMMERSION at the five-sixteenths, came three wide into the stretch and capitulated.
