**Footnotes**

STRING KING went three wide on the first turn, was rated just off the pace while on the outside, inched closer while three then two wide on the far turn, was put to a drive in upper stretch, rallied on the inside of WILDRALLY, surged between rivals late and gamely prevailed under strong urging. KISSIMMEE KYLE was well rated while setting the pace, responded well when asked passing the three-sixteenths pole, led gamely into the final sixteenth but was denied at the wire. WILDRALLY saved ground on the first turn, settled off the pace, moved closer with a half-mile to run, chased four then three wide on the far turn, was put to the whip in upper stretch, rallied on the outside of STRING KING, closed well on the outside and just missed in a three-way photo. IDEFROMTHEBAYOU was well placed on the inside, came under urging on the far turn, moved out near the furlong marker and lacked the needed kick. OLD BUSHMILL settled in the middle of the field, raced three wide while in tight quarters early on the far turn, continued three wide into the stretch, moved out for the drive and failed to rally. IDE LIKE A DOUBLE lagged at the rear of the field, was roused on the far turn and also failed to rally. FIRST TO BINGO raced three wide on the first turn, settled off the pace, lacked room behind PRODUCTIVE ENVOY near the five-sixteenths pole, came under a drive in upper stretch and was no factor. CANDIANO was reserved towards the rear, moved closer with a half-mile to run, went five then four wide on the far turn and came up empty. PRODUCTIVE ENVOY tracked the pace, came up empty on the far turn and faded. (Rail at 20 Feet)
