Footnotes

FLAT GONE settled on the inside, angled three wide near the three-eighths pole, moved to four wide at the five-sixteenths, rallied into the stretch, closed well to get the lead inside the three-sixteenths pole, drifted in some while edging clear into the final furlong and proved best under strong urging. GENERAL IKE ran off while rank and very hard to rate, opened up a sizeable advantage, saw the lead diminish coming to the quarter-pole, lost the advantage in upper stretch, kept on well after being passed by the winner and finished willingly for the place. IRISH YOU WELL went three then two wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, raced off the rail early on the far turn, angled four wide near the three-eighths pole, moved to five wide at the five-sixteenths pole, gained into the stretch, drifted in near the three-sixteenths, moved out inside the furlong marker and got up for the show. UNION EXPRESS went three then two wide on the first turn, followed the runaway leader from second, was ridden along in the two path on the far turn, gained coming to the quarter-pole, chased into the final furlong and weakened. INDIAN PEGASUS raced off the rail early on the first turn then dropped to the inside, settled well off the pace, was urged along while inside early on the far turn then came off the rail, advanced into the stretch, chased under a drive while behind rivals, moved in and out a bit then came up empty. DANZIG GOLD broke out at the start, lagged at the rear, saved ground on the far turn and failed to threaten. STREET PRANCER went four then three wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, was urged along while off the rail on the far turn and failed to respond.
