**Footnotes**

VICAR'S IN TROUBLE contested the pace in the two path on the first turn, moved to a solo lead near the five-eighths pole, vied inside on the far turn, responded well when asked at the quarter-pole, drew off under a right-handed whip in upper stretch, switched to a left-handed whip at the furlong marker and proved much the best under steady urging. INTENSE HOLIDAY was rated while just off the inside on the first turn, raced just off the pace while under some restraint, steadied slightly while bumping with LOUIES FLOWER leaving the backstretch, was asked shortly thereafter, chased two then three wide, made a bid at the five-sixteenths, dropped in while under a left-handed whip after turning into the stretch, came very close to the rail while cross firing, pursued the winner under a drive and proved no match while able to get the place. COMMANDING CURVE was bumped at the start and forced in, saved ground on the first turn, settled at the back, went three to four wide on the far turn, advanced at the five-sixteenths, came under the whip in upper stretch and safely secured the show. IN TROUBLE went three wide on the first turn, tracked the pace, shifted out midway down the backstretch and bumped with ALBANO, chased three to four wide on the far turn and weakened. ALBANO went four wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, was bumped midway down the backstretch and forced out, raced four wide while ridden along on the far turn and tired. FLAT GONE settled on the inside, came off the rail near the five-sixteenths, raced behind a rival coming to the quarter-pole, angled out in upper stretch and failed to respond. KING CYRUS raced in the two path on the first turn, was urged along on the backstretch, came under a stronger ride while near the inside on the far turn and was no factor. GOLD HAWK went three wide on the first turn, settled off the pace, raced two then three wide on the far turn, dropped back while in tight between rivals inside the five-sixteenths pole, was carried out in upper stretch and came up empty. LOUIES FLOWER disputed the pace on the inside, dropped back near the five-eighths pole, raced just behind the winner, bumped with INTENSE HOLIDAY leaving the backstretch, fell back while along the rail on the far turn and faded. RISE UP broke in and bumped with a rival, went five wide on the first turn, moved up on the outside with five furlongs to run, tracked the pace from that point, chased in the two path on the far turn and stopped. Following a stewards inquiry into the run down the backstretch, IN TROUBLE was disqualified from fourth and placed fifth.
