TOSHEEN pulled his way to the early lead, angled in and set the pace inside, inched away again on the second turn, fought back along the rail in the stretch and went willingly to the wire. SIR MACHO angled in early then came off the rail on the first turn, chased outside a rival or a bit off the fence, came out in the stretch and finished with interest. TUFF STORM chased between horses then a bit off the rail, angled in on the backstretch, saved ground thereafter and bested the others. MY SECRET AFFAIR angled in and stalked off the rail, bid outside the runner-up on the backstretch, tracked that one again on the second turn, lugged in a bit in midstretch and weakened in the final furlong. FLAT GONE angled in and saved ground off the pace, went outside a rival on the second turn and into the stretch and lacked a rally. MAGNA WARRIOR chased three deep on the first turn then outside a rival on the backstretch and second turn and weakened in the drive. OLDTIMERS VISION angled in and saved ground off the pace, continued inside on the second turn and did not rally.
