SAVON chased the early pace from the outside, inched closer entering the turn, gained the margin at the eighth pole and was clear late while under steady urging. DOUBLE STEAL forced the early pace from the outside, advanced entering the turn, responded to pressure but could only gain the place. NIGHT MASK forced the early pace from the outside, inched closer entering the turn, responded but was too late. MARDI GRAS MAN stalked the early pace from the outside, made a bid entering the turn and finished well but too late. CHICOT BAY outrun early, responded entering the drive and had good energy late. GLAD TRIBUTE forced the early pace from between foes but had nothing left for the drive. WHAT'S UP POP was bothered early when in tight and no threat. MARKET INNATE DUDE dueled from the inside and tired. VALID PROMISE dueled from the outside and tired. MALO MAN was no factor. ENTREPRENEUR TO had little interest. I'M NO PLUTO was no menace. REAL COLE CAT forced the early pace and gave way.
