MUSIC STREET dueled from the outside for the early lead, remained engaged through the turn, gained a clear margin at the eighth pole and was clear late while kept to task. ALL THINGS GOLD chased the early pace from the outside, crept closer entering the turn, responded but could not reach the winner. RUSHMORE stalked the early going from the inside, advanced entering the turn, responded but could only gain the show. SHERIFF'S BIG GUN dueled from the inside early, battled through the turn but tired in the drive. MARDI GRAS MAN went evenly. COHEN'S BANDITO could only pass tired ones. GLAD TRIBUTE was no factor. EL TORO ROJO was no threat. WHOA WHAM drifted eight wide into the turn and was no factor. FLY LIL DEVIL up close early from between foes, gave way.
