**Footnotes**

CAPE RACE chased the pace on the inside of PETERS ROCK, made a bid while two to three wide on the turn, edged clear under a left-handed whip in upper stretch, switched to a right-handed whip outside the sixteenth-pole then was given two quick strikes in succession and proved much the best late under a strong hand ride. PETERS ROCK brushed with a rival at the start, chased the pace on the outside, raced four then three wide on the turn, pursued the winner under the whip in upper stretch and narrowly earned the place while no match for the winner. RICHMOND COUNTY settled between rivals early then came under urging outside the half-mile pole and dropped in, raced inside early on the turn, came off the rail while advancing late on the bend, turned into the stretch just behind the leaders, came under a drive shortly thereafter, chased the winner under the whip into the final furlong and also proved no match but missed the place. BOLD WOLF was ridden along on the outside, went four wide on the turn, came five wide into the stretch and narrowly missed the trifecta. EMERALD CRESCENT brushed with an opponent at the start, was urged along towards the rear, lugged out a bit leaving the backstretch, went three to four wide on the turn and failed to threaten. HUSTLIN NU was coaxed along on the outside, moved in leaving the backstretch, went two to three wide on the turn and came up empty. BRAVO HABIBI was last away then showed no speed, saved ground on the turn and was no factor. CANEROS quickly sped clear, set the pace, lugged out leaving the backstretch then bobbled slightly, was wrestled back to the inside shortly thereafter, vied into the stretch and gave way.
