LIL BIT O'FUN chased between horses down the hill, came out into the stretch and rallied under left handed urging in the stretch then split foes to get up on the wire. HE'S A DANCE STAR sped to the early lead, set the pace a bit off the rail, dueled leaving the hill and in the stretch, fought back to a short lead in deep stretch and was edged late. MR. BOSSY PANTS stalked three deep then bid alongside the runner-up leaving the hill, took a short lead in the stretch, fought back in deep stretch and was outgamed late. DEPRECIABLE chased a bit off the rail then inside, came out into the stretch, split horses in midstretch, angled inward in deep stretch and finished with interest. A TOAST TO YOU stalked outside then four wide on the hill and five wide into the stretch and was outfinished. ROMEO ROYALE settled off the rail or outside a rival, came out into the stretch and found his best stride late. IVANHO dropped back off the rail then angled in on the hill, came out in the stretch and had a late bid between foes. KOAST stalked between horses, came out into the stretch and lacked the needed late kick. RELENTLESS HEAT angled in and saved ground chasing the pace to the stretch and could not offer the necessary response. HUSTLIN

NU stalked inside then bid along the rail between calls on the hill, fell back some leaving the hill and weakened. NEWFOUND GOLD saved ground chasing the pace, came out a bit into the stretch and did not rally. SACRED OVATION pulled between horses to stalk the pace, continued three deep down the hill, drifted four wide into the stretch, gave way and was eased late, did not return to be unsaddled when bleeding from the nostrils and was vanned off. Rail on hill at zero.
