Footnotes

ROYAL AGO settled near the back of the field, raced two to three wide on the turn, rallied behind TI TOWNSHIP in upper stretch, closed strongly outside that rival in the final furlong and got up at the wire. TI TOWNSHIP settled off the pace while under some urging, was put to a right-handed whip while off the rail on the turn, swung out once straightened for the drive, rallied on the outside, lugged in a bit while making a bid passing the furlong marker, led into the final sixteenth but was denied at the wire. JET RAIDER contested the pace on the inside, was put to a left-handed whip in upper stretch, failed to keep up with the top two in the final sixteenth but determinedly earned the show. CREDIT ONLY was fractious in the gate, disputed the pace while between rivals, came under the whip in upper stretch, battled into the final sixteenth and weakened then just missed the show. BURT'S A STITCH settled on the inside, saved ground on the turn, moved out a bit in upper stretch and lacked the needed response. HANDS ON tracked the trio of leaders from fourth, chased four wide on the turn and tired. UNEXPECTED VALOR was fractious in the gate then broke through the front and got loose, was nicely captured by the outrider after expending minimal effort for a little over a furlong, was deemed fit to run by the state veterinarian, came out in front, contested the pace on the outside, chased three wide on the turn and gave way.
