MONEY CANNON unhurried early from the outside, steadily advanced up the backstretch, reached a striking position entering the second turn, responded to duel through the drive and outnodded LAST MUSIC the final strides. LAST MUSIC allowed to settle early, steadily advanced outside entering the second turn, responded entering the drive, dueled with the winner through the stretch but was outnodded. LEES STONE well placed from the inside, held a forward position entering the second turn, dueled through the drive but could not match strides. TONY BOY chased the early pace from the outside, made a bid entering the second turn and finished well. ANNI'S STORM chased the early pace from the outside but had nothing left. BADTOTHETHEBONEBLAKE dueled from the inside and tired. PADDLE HEELS dueled from the outside early, was steadied mid stretch when in tight then faded. MR. RAMOS showed little.
