Footnotes

SPACE RUNNER sped to the early lead outside, angled in and set the pace a bit off the rail then inside on the turn, came just off the fence in the stretch and held on gamely under urging. MANEWAL was in a good position stalking the pace inside, came out leaving the turn and into the stretch and held second. LUZ ATTICUS stalked between horses then off the rail, came out on the turn and four wide into the stretch and bested the others. MONEY CANNON stalked three deep on the backstretch and turn, came four wide into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. BILLY WIN three wide early, stalked outside a rival, went three deep leaving the turn and into the stretch and also lacked a rally. BUBBA FIZZ chased off the rail then went between horses leaving the backstretch and on the turn, came out three wide into the stretch and could not offer the necessary response. WILD TONY broke a bit slowly, saved ground chasing the pace throughout and lacked a response in the stretch.
