Footnotes

NO RACHMONES bumped at the start, dueled between horses throughout, took a short lead in midstretch, drifted out a bit from the whip and bumped with the runner-up a sixteenth out and held on gamely under urging. WILDCAT MOON stumbled at the start but recovered quickly, went up between horses then pressed the pace three wide throughout, bumped with the winner a sixteenth out and continued gamely to the wire. RESISTANT stalked the pace inside, came out leaving the turn and three deep into the stretch, came out again past midstretch and finished willingly. MONEY CANNON broke out and raced wide early, settled off the rail, angled to the inside on the turn, came out in midstretch and split foes on the line. GREELEY AWESOME sent inside to duel for the lead, fought back on the turn and in the stretch and was outfinished. STEPHEN'S PRIDE settled between foes then off the rail to the stretch and found his best stride late outside. DANCER HUMOR broke out a bit, settled between horses then off the rail, angled in some for the turn and could not offer the necessary late kick. HARLINGTON NIGHT chased three deep then outside on the turn and into the stretch and weakened. DEREKSON chased between foes then three deep, continued off the rail on the turn, drifted in some in the stretch and also weakened.
