Footnotes

HUNGER angled over to take the lead into the first turn, relinquished the advantage leaving the turn, stalked outside the pacesetter on the backstretch, dueled outside that foe on the second turn, took a short lead at the quarter pole, inched away at the top of the stretch and held the advantage to the wire under urging. BEAST OF BOURBON was floated out by a rival around the first turn, chased on the outside down the backstretch, angled in to save some ground on the second turn, came back out to enter the lane four wide, could not catch the winner but gained the place. MONEY CANNON drifted out around the first turn, chased off the rail down the backstretch and three deep around the second turn, could not match strides with the winner in the final furlong and was outfinished for the place. HARDLINER saved ground around the first turn, moved closer on the rail down the backstretch, came outside a rival leaving the quarter pole, angled back towards the rail in the final furlong and lacked the needed rally. PENNY MAKER angled over to save ground around the first turn, chased on the inside, came out for the stretch drive and did not offer a bid in the final furlong. SHACKBAMALAMA was hustled out of the gate, pulled outside a rival around the first turn, took over the lead leaving the turn, set the pace off the rail down the backstretch, dueled inside the winner on the second turn, and weakened through the lane.
