Footnotes

MONEY CANNON forced the pace from between rivals into and on the turn, gained slim advantage entering the stretch, inched away to mid-stretch then gamely held under strong hand pressure. TAHOE FLASH was bumped at the start but quickly recovered and prompted the pace three deep, bid three abreast midway on the turn, continued on same path into the stretch and gained the place. ONE FIRM CAT bumped with inside foe leaving the gate, stalked from the inside, angled three wide leaving the turn, came out bit further in the drive and got up in final strides for third. BOTCH was sent up inside to briefly lead then contested the pace from along the rail, dropped back slightly passing mid-stretch, fought back gamely under urging but then gave ground grudgingly in final yards. I DON'T CARE WHO tracked leaders from off the rail, remained on three wide path, came out further entering the stretch and finished willingly. PROUD STEP settled well off the pace, angled over and chased from the inside, shifted out leaving the turn then came back in some late while no factor. HARDLINER stalked from between rivals, continued on two wide path to the bend, dropped back around the turn and weakened.
