Footnotes

IT'S NO SECRET took command early by a slight margin, remained clear heading into the turn and continued clear in the stretch. THEKINGOFTEXAS stalked the early front runners, raced four wide in the turn and finished second best. BRYSON'S COMET raced up close behind the early pacesetter, continued bid heading into the stretch and held on for show in final strides. NACHOORDINARYGUY settled in behind the early front runners, made a bid heading into the turn and had a mild gain in the stretch. RAYS SOUTHERN JAZZ raced near the back of the pack early and steadily gained ground in the stretch. SPEED TO BROADWAY raced evenly and failed to kick in late. BUZZ ON THE MOUNT raced up close early and steadily faded after a half. COCKY AND BOLD saved ground along the inside and was never a threat. NIX STAR raced evenly and failed to rally. SIR SULLY raced up close early, edged up to the leader at the top of the lane and had nothing left late. PADRE MIO was off slowly away from the gate and was never a factor. BAMA PARKWAY made a brief bid in the early going and steadily faded after a half. LEESTOWN EXPRESS ducked in at the start and eased up in the stretch.
