HONORARY GALLOP went four early on the first turn then dropped in, made her way to the rail before entering the backstretch, settled towards the rear, moved closer while inside on the far turn, was asked at the quarter-pole, rallied in upper stretch, chased into the final furlong, made a bid at the sixteenth-pole and narrowly prevailed under strong urging. BEVERLY BELLE dropped in early on the first turn, settled towards the rail, moved closer on the

far turn, was asked coming to the quarter-pole, chased into the final furlong, made a bid at the sixteenth-pole, battled with the winner late and just missed. NIKITA'S SECRET saved ground on the first turn, settled off the pace, was urged along in the two path early on the far turn, shifted four wide outside the quarter-pole, rallied in the final furlong and closed well to just miss. TUNICA GIRL went five then four wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, advanced four wide on the far turn, made a bid just after turning into the stretch, battled into the final sixteenth then missed and was denied the trifecta. ALIVIA'S LION went four then three wide on the first turn, was well placed in third position, advanced three wide on the far turn, made a bid at the quarter-pole, battled into the final sixteenth and was outfinished. FLATTERACIOUS went five wide early on the first turn, dropped to two to three wide shortly thereafter, lingered well back in the field, moved up near the seven-sixteenths, saved ground on the far turn, shifted out under a drive approaching the furlong marker and lacked the needed response. BRITTANY'S TUITION raced in the two path on the first turn, settled well off the pace, went two to three wide on the far turn, angled out in upper stretch and failed to threaten. GRANDE CHICA raced off the rail early on the first turn then dropped to the inside, set the pace, vied along the rail on the far turn, dropped back under a drive in upper stretch and gave way. PREMO'S STAR raced in the two path on the first turn, settled off the pace, went two then three wide on the far turn, came five wide into the stretch and was no factor. WHAT A SIGHT went four to five wide on the first turn, settled well back while on the outside, raced three wide on the far turn and never reached contention. EVANGELINEWAITONME went three then two wide on the first turn, prompted the pace on the outside, drew even near the half-mile pole, was urged along while outside on the far turn and tired. SWEET FRANGIPANI raced two to three wide on both turns and showed little. SOD GODDESS went four wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, dropped back while five wide on the far turn and faltered.
