Footnotes

GREAT MILLS HIGH went four then three wide on the first turn, settled off the pace, raced in the two path on the far turn, was asked outside the quarter-pole, came under a drive in upper stretch, shifted out outside the furlong marker, rallied on the outside and closed well to get up late. ALIVIA'S LION went four wide early on the first turn then dropped to one off the rail, stalked the pace on the outside, chased on the far turn, pursued the winner under a drive into the final furlong, gained the lead at the sixteenth-pole but was denied near the wire. FLIPSTER went three wide early on the first turn then dropped to the inside, set the pace through tepid fractions, controlled the action while inside on the far turn, was asked at the quarter-pole, came under the whip in upper stretch, was collared near the sixteenth-pole then outfinished while well clear for the place. NIKITA'S SECRET was rank into the first turn, raced inside on that bend, was reserved off the pace, went two then three wide on the far turn, angled five wide into the stretch and improved position. MISS MORONETTE settled on the inside, saved ground through the far turn, came under the whip in upper stretch and failed to rally. BRITTANY'S TUITION went five wide early on the first turn then dropped to three wide, settled off the pace, went three wide on the far turn, came four wide into the stretch and failed to threaten. HONORARY GALLOP went three then two wide on the first turn, settled between rivals, continued between horses on the far turn and was no factor. ARAGORN'S QUEEN went three wide early on the first turn then dropped to the rail, was well placed just off the pace, raced inside on the far turn and came up empty. BRIANS FANCY was taken up some while rank into the first turn, raced near the inside on that bend, lingered near the back, went three to four wide on the far turn and showed little. SHE SLEEPS went four wide early on the first turn then dropped to the two path, settled just off the pace while on the outside, went three wide on the far turn and capitulated. ROCK ELLE TEN went two to three wide on the turns and was outrun. (Rail at 18 Feet)
