LUCKY TRADITION raced three then two wide on the first turn, set the pace, was asked near the quarter-pole, came under pressure in upper stretch, dueled gamely with ORDINARY TIME in the final furlong and just missed. SAVIANO raced five then four wide on the first turn, tracked the leader on the outside, chased while off the rail on the far turn and tired while best of the rest. CONNER CAN raced three wide on the first turn, settled at the back, passed a few rivals while three then four wide on the far turn, came five wide into the stretch and failed to threaten. MR. SOUL settled on the inside, was roused on the far turn, came off the rail near the five-sixteenths pole and also failed to threaten. PHARME LEGEND raced four then three wide on the first turn, settled in the middle of the field, was urged along while off the rail on the far turn and failed to respond. WING A DING dropped to the inside on the first turn, raced up close to the pace, was urged along on the backstretch, came up empty on the far turn and faded.
