PLANO ZIP was allowed to settled then rallied heading into the far turn while two wide, angled inside in upper stretch four clear running room then powered to the front in late stretch and was best in the end. MONSIEUR HOOD was allowed to settled then rallied on the far turn while two wide, bumped with SOUTH CHINA SEA in upper stretch then gained command in mid stretch but failed to sustained that bid in the end. SOUTH CHINA SEA set the early pace and drew off on the run down the backstretch, was bumped in upper stretch then weakened in late stretch. CHRISAGOGO was allowed to settled then rallied on the far turn while four wide making a strong bid to upper stretch then raced evenly in the end. ITSY BITSY WALK was unhurried early then rallied on the far turn while three wide, swung out to be seven wide in upper stretch but flattened out in the drive. ARKHOMA was unhurried early on then raced three wide into the far turn but was no threat in the end. CAJUN RAINDANCE was allowed to settled while inside, made a bid on the far turn to range up then faltered in the stretch drive. TRAVELING STONE was allowed to settled while racing six wide on the backstretch but was no threat. KAYOU chased the early pace while three wide, was used up then gave way.
