Footnotes

EUGENE'S MOMENT showed early speed then dropped just behind the pacesetter, raced inside on the turn, rallied along the rail in upper stretch, closed strongly to get the lead inside the furlong marker, kicked clear into the final sixteenth and just held under strong urging. JOYCE'S REBEL was urged along while just off the pace, dropped back leaving the backstretch, raced off the rail on the turn, moved out in upper stretch, lacked room in traffic outside the furlong marker, found room passing that marker and closed well to just miss. GUSTAV BAY was taken in hand early then settled at the rear, went three to four wide on the turn, came five wide into the stretch and got up for the show. PREACHIN DEACON set the pace under pressure, lost the lead in upper stretch, chased into the final furlong, drifted out near the sixteenth-pole, brushed with BEANWAH'SMACHINE and weakened then lost the show. BEANWAH'SMACHINE bumped with a rival at the start, pressed the pace, vied two to three wide on the turn, led into the final furlong, dropped back under a drive, brushed with PREACHIN DEACON near the sixteenth-pole and tired. RAISEANOTHERGATOR bumped with an opponent at the start, pressed the pace, vied three to four wide on the turn and gave way. BUCKTOWN was urged along on the outside, went three wide on the turn, shifted four wide into the stretch and came up empty.
