CONQUEST SURE SHOT saved ground just off the pace behind the cover of LUCKY LOU PAL, came under urging five-sixteenths from home, spun just off the inside for home, tipped to the three path three-sixteenths from home, got on track rallying inside the final eighth and just got up to collar the embattled top pair in the last strides to the finish. MASTER MERION established the front and showed the way just off the inside pulling on the bit mouth agape through the opening bend as the rider attempted to settle his charge, showed the way settling into a rhythm in hand down the backstretch under attendance to the outside, came under coaxing five-sixteenths from home as that escort upped the pressure at that station, cut the corner into upper stretch fully extended, dug in stubbornly fending off his main pace rival holding sway, then was nailed in the last jumps to the wire. UNBRIDLED EAGLE attended the pace of the aforementioned foe in hand two to three wide latched on to the outside of the leader, came under urging five-sixteenths from home increasing the pressure on the front, spun just off the inside into upper stretch under a drive, dug in fighting on heads apart for command through the length of the drive, got repelled by the leader, then got collared in tandem with his main pace rival in the last strides to the finish and forced to settle for the show honors. LUCKY LOU PAL took to the inside into the first turn to track the pace along the inside under rating, bobbled midway on the bend taking an awkward step when hopping slightly possibly attempting to jump a gap in the hedge along the inside, set up behind the cover of the leader, MASTER MERION, remaining in hand until put to a ride five-sixteenths from home, angled four wide into upper stretch, kept on through the drive for the last major share. OUR STORMIN NORMAN got bumped and squeezed back at the start between foes due to mostly pressure from KEYNESIAN, took to the hedge and was again bumped by KEYNESIAN as that foe grew a bit erratic when steadied off the heels of ONE OF A KIND just prior to entering the first turn, got put to a firm hold and remained patiently handled just off the inside near the rear, came under coaxing nearing the five-sixteenths, swung four wide at the quarter pole and improved position by mostly tired foes with a mild kick. OSCAR PERFORMANCE bumped after the start in a chain of bumping begun by PIAZZA DEL CAMPO who grew a bit erratic crossing to the three path, saved ground in mid pack behind the cover of CONQUEST SURE SHOT in hand, came under a ride three furlongs from home, cornered just off the inside into upper stretch and passed tired foes in the lane. ONE OF A KIND bumped after the start due

to pressure from PIAZZA DEL CAMPO coming inwards, chased three then two wide from near the rear under encouragement from three furlongs out, swung just off the inside for home and offered no response. KEYNESIAN broke in at the start bumping and squeezing back OUR STORMIN NORMAN, against ONE OF A KIND, fought the bit early on and steadied briefly off heels of ONE OF A KIND into the first turn growing erratic showing greenness to the rider's direction and bumped with OUR STORMIN NORMAN before settling two to three wide near the rear, came under coaxing three furlongs from home, cut the corner into upper stretch and made no impact. PIAZZA DEL CAMPO came in after the start bumping KEYNESIAN into ONE OF A KIND and in turn OSCAR PERFORMANCE, settled three then two wide in pursuit from mid pack behind the cover of UNBRIDLED EAGLE, came under urging three furlongs from home, swung three wide into upper stretch and weakened in the drive. SAHARA STORM three wide through the first turn, raced three wide in range of the front coming under coaxing half a mile from home, angled out five wide at the head of the stretch and tired. THERE WAS A TIMER MALFUNCTION AND NO FRACTIONAL TIMES WERE AVAILABLE.
