IT'S YOUR NICKEL pulled under restraint into the first turn, went around that bend in the two path, was reserved off the pace, saved ground early on the far turn then came off the hedge, was asked inside the five-sixteenths, dropped back to the inside at the quarter-pole then cut the corner into the stretch, commenced a rally under a left-handed whip, switched to a right-handed whip while gaining outside the sixteenth-pole, went back to a left-handed whip late and got up in an excellent ride. OISEAU DE GUERRE was taken in hand early, had DANNY'S RUSH clip his heels past the wire for the first time, was eager while trying to be given cover by the rider, fought those tactics in the three then four path on the initial bend, moved up quickly early on the backstretch, stalked the leading duo from that point, made a premature move in the three path on the far turn, took the lead coming to the five-sixteenths, dropped to the two path while moving clear outside the quarter-pole, was set down in upper stretch, opened up a sizable advantage into the final furlong, was put to a left-handed whip outside the sixteenth-pole, had the rider take a nervous peek behind him then realized he pushed the button too soon and was caught while just able to save the place. SOGLIO broke a step slow, went around the first turn in the two path, settled on the outside near the back, was roused in the four path on the far turn, swung six wide into the stretch, gained on the outside, was put to a left-handed whip in the vicinity of the furlong marker and finished well to just miss the place. MASTER PLAN was urged into the first turn while a bit green, saved ground on that bend, settled towards the rear, was ridden along in the four path on the far turn and finished willingly for the last spot in the superfecta. SHAMSAAN broke a step slow, was in a bit tight against the hedge approaching the first turn, saved ground on that bend, settled in the back half of the field, raced inside on the far turn, spun into the two path entering the stretch, came under a right-handed whip near the three-sixteenths, shifted out behind horses at the sixteenth-pole and failed to threaten. SAHARA STORM came between horses passing the seven-eighths pole, was rated in the two path on the first turn, pulled his way up to contest the pace early on the backstretch, vied in the two path on the far turn, was urged along between horses passing the five-sixteenths, dropped back into the stretch and tired. DANNY'S RUSH clipped the heels of OISEAU DE GUERRE early and stumbled, became very rank under restraint in the two to three path on the first

turn, was reserved off the pace, went three wide on the far turn under urging and failed to rally. HAVE ANOTHER broke about two lengths slow, saved ground on the first turn, settled near the back, rounded the far turn in the two path while still unasked, was roused inside the five-sixteenths, swung five wide into the stretch, drifted out a bit near the furlong marker and was no factor. ARCHIVAL went three to four wide on the first turn, settled in the front half of the field, dropped back under urging in the two then three path on the far turn, floated four wide into the stretch and came up empty. PUT THE BOSS BACK was hustled to the lead, opened a clear advantage along the hedge on the first turn, was joined on the outside near the five-eighths pole, vied inside on the far turn, dropped out late on that bend, was crowded while falling back at the quarter-pole and stopped.
