QUEST FOR JOY outrun early, advanced inside entering the second turn, altered outside entering the drive, was bumped entering the drive, came inside, was bumped again mid stretch, responded and was just up late. BELIKESIS broke sharp from the inside, gained a clear early margin, remained clear up the backstretch, remained well clear entering the second turn, held a wide advantage deep stretch but was caught. MACARONI'S DEELITE stalked the early pace from the inside, advanced entering the second turn, responded entering the drive, bumped with the winner mid stretch and finished gamely. PANCHO PUDDLES chased the early pace from the outside, crept closer entering the second turn, bumped with the winner mid stretch then went evenly late. MS MARIGOLD chased the early pace from the outside but had no late response. LASS WEST could only improve position. PHILOSOPHER pressed the early pace and tired. HOTTIE'S DEELITE was no factor. SOUTHERN SADIE close up early, tired. FORTUNE LEAP had a steady fade. SECRET BABE chased the early pace and gave way.
