Footnotes

PURPLE BARBIE broke in at the start and brushed with a rival, settled while off the inside, was asked near the five-sixteenths pole, rallied three wide into the stretch, took over near the three-sixteenths pole, edged clear into the final furlong and held under urging then was eased up in the final strides. TAP IT TWICE tracked the pacesetter on the outside, drew even with five furlongs to run, vied outside on the far turn, led into the stretch, lost the lead near the three-sixteenths pole, lost contact with the winner into the final furlong, moved to the outside and finished willingly to get the place. MAKENZIE'S MAGIC bumped lightly with rivals at the start, settled near the inside, was roused while a bit off the rail on the far turn, came under the whip in upper stretch and lacked the needed response while able to get the show. SILVER BULLET GAL bumped lightly with a rival at the start, set the pace on the inside, was joined on the outside by TAP IT TWICE with five furlongs to run, vied inside on the far turn, dropped back while under a drive in upper stretch and gave way. NUMBER ONE GAL raced three wide on the first turn, settled towards the rear, was urged along while three wide on the far turn and failed to threaten. STORMY TARA raced three to four wide on the first turn, lagged at the rear of the field, was urged along while four wide on the far turn and was no factor. BELLA GRANDE was bumped lightly on both sides at the start then squeezed back, settled off the pace while towards the inside, came up empty on the far turn and dropped out.
