Footnotes

ORIZA was asked a bit from the start, went to the early lead then was taken in hand, set the clear pace while under restraint, was given some free rein while off the rail on the far turn, tightened it up on TWILIGHT ROSS when he made a rail bid in upper stretch, dueled gamely with that rival in the final furlong and narrowly prevailed under strong right hand urging in a head-bobbing finish. TWILIGHT ROSS was reserved on the inside, moved closer midway down the backstretch, waited patiently while continuing to save ground on the far turn, squeezed through on the rail in upper stretch, took a bit of an odd step outside the eighth-pole, dueled gamely with ORIZA in the final furlong and was denied in a tight photo. TAKIN' THE BULLET raced three wide on the first turn, was rated while tracking the leader, chased three wide on the far turn and weakened while clear for the show. ZARROZZI raced inside on the first turn, settled at the back of the field, was urged along while off the rail on the far turn and failed to rally. RYNO'S HOMERUN was reluctant to load, raced a bit off the inside on the first turn, was rated off the pace, shifted four wide near the three-eighths pole, came under strong urging near the five-sixteenths pole, continued four wide into the stretch and had nothing left. BUCK'S REVENGE settled towards the rear of the field, raced inside on the far turn and failed to respond.
