SADIE'S SOLDIER reserved early just off the inside, continued back under patient handling into far turn, split foes past the furlong marker, closed well to be up in time. CLASSIC CASCADE stalked the pace along the inside, continued forward second turn, waited along the rail turning for home, moved out, took, over, led late, caught. MERKABAH also settled off the pace, asked along late in the final turn, angled in slightly midstretch, between foes, lacked a winning response, outfinished for the show. DANDY'S LEGACY in hand and off the pace, raced outside, bit closer into the stretch, could not do much with the top two late, proved game for the show. UP AND OUT OF SITE lacked speed while saving ground, in some traffic second turn, also was found lacking in the drive, finished up evenly. WICKED VOW back off the pace, traffic into to the straight, improved position slightly no real threat. IDEFROMTHEBAYOU within striking distance off the inside, came up empty for the drive. BERGMAN forwardly placed, continued to race close into the lane, gave way final furlong. UNITAS pressured the early pace and gave way. PIRATE ISLAND showed the way along the inside for over six furlongs, gave way when headed just inside the furlong grounds. CANDIANO last away, trailed throughout.
