LEE'S SPIRIT unhurried for five furlongs, came five wide into the lane when beginning to rally, set down, finished with a flourish to win going away. GO PUBLIC forwardly placed, continued to prompt the leader up the backstretch, took over when straightened for home, no match for the winner, held the place. THE MALLARD MAN last away, raced back and off the inside, three wide and in some traffic into the lane, steered out a bit for room nearing midstretch tightening up TOUGH BRUSH, finished up willingly to be getting to the runner up. UP AND OUT OF SITE settled off the pace, moved closer toward the inside late in the final turn, lacked a further advance and finished up evenly. KARAMA lacked speed while saving ground, continued inside, got through rail midstretch, improved slightly, pulled up short, vanned off. TOUGH BRUSH raced off the pace, fell back some the middle half mile, was beginning to pick up the pace upper stretch when forced to take up in tight quarters, bobbled then finished up evenly to earn the dead heat for fifth. SLIGO JOE closest to the early leader, continued forward while outside in the second turn, gave way in the drive. ROCKGLEN set the pace for five furlongs, stopped when headed by the runner up into the stretch.
